



## **School Sense Program – Rules & Regulations**

### **Program Dates:**

The School Sense Program began on September 2, 2008 and will end on December 10, 2010. Program may be extended through the school year at the discretion of Monmouth Mall.

### **Eligibility:**

All Monmouth County public, private and parochial schools are eligible to receive school supplies through the School Sense Program, provided they meet program requirements. The administration office of each eligible school has received complete program information. Each eligible school should appoint a designated School Sense Representative.

### **Requirements:**

Sales receipts from purchases made at Monmouth Mall (including Macy's, JCPenney, Lord & Taylor, AMC Theatre, Chili's, TGI Fridays and all other mall restaurants & eateries, and Monmouth Mall gift cards) must be presented within 30 days of purchase, or by December 10, 2010, whichever date is earlier, to the Monmouth Mall Customer Service Center for validation.

When sales receipts are validated, an equivalent "point" amount will be credited to the school chosen by the receipt holder. All purchase receipts presented for validation at any one time may be credited to only one school.

Schools may accumulate points during the program time-frame above. As schools acquire the minimum number of points as designated on the official order form, the School Sense School Representative may order equipment as directed. Equipment subject to availability at time of order.

Points not redeemed by December 10, 2010 will rollover until the following year in January 2011, if the program is continuing into 2011. Otherwise, points not redeemed by 12/10/10 will be forfeited.

Monmouth Mall Management reserves the right to make changes to the School Sense Program and these Official Rules and Regulations at its discretion.
